Media invitation to Land Monitor Report Launch

Media outlets are invited to attend the launch of the 2023 Land Monitor Report.

RDA Riverina has collaborated with Housing Industry Association Wagga and Committee 4 Wagga to publish this essential study into land availability in our city and its surrounds.

The report provides a valuable insight to the supply and demand of housing in Wagga.

As has been the case in recent reports, the 2023 version shows Wagga is battling a housing crisis. Further details will be provided at the launch.

An economics report on what the undersupply means for Wagga will also be unveiled.

The media conference will be held at 1pm on Wednesday (December 6) on the corner of Gurwood and Shaw streets (adjacent to the Weissel Oval development in central Wagga).
